Returned books will be sanitized and recirculated once a proper amount of time has passed. Curbside pick-up is still available for anyone who prefers that service. Or grab a good book and enjoy it in the Remembrance Garden.






Our most fun activity for children is back...two books, 2 locations!






Summer Book Discussions


Wednesday Evenings – All are welcome!


Chutney & Jams for Sale!


Children's Reading Club
